

**Listen to Ms. Lin
The Flap**

Explanation with examples

Double “t” is often pronounced with a /d/ sound. This is called the alveolar flap.

Examples:

Butter	Letter	Little	Bottle	Pretty
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The flap also happens when the letter “t” comes between two vowels.

Examples:

Water	Whatever	Go to	Title	Hurt a (hurt a lot)
